1. Championship status competitions

Ekurhuleni Bowls competitions considered to be of Championship status are:

- 1.1. Open Men's and Women's singles;
- 1.2. Veteran Men's and Women's singles;
- 1.3. Open Men's and Women's pairs;
- 1.4. Veteran Men's pairs;
- 1.5. Men's and Women's triples;
- 1.6. Men's and Women's fours;
- 1.7. Mixed pairs;
- 1.8. Champion of Champions.

2. Player Ranking System

In order to foster a greater interest in the game of bowls as well as to provide an indicator of the individual player skills progression and current form, a system of player ranking is in place.

The system is points based and thirty points is awarded to each player for each level of achievement attained in each of the EKB Championship events as defined in paragraph 2. above except for the Champion of Champions. As an example, 30 points are awarded for entry into a competition, 30 points for qualifying for the knockout stage, 30 points accumulated for each round progressed in the knockout stage and a further 30 for the win.

There are no points awarded for participation in any tournament other than those defined in this document.

The selectors will use the ranking system as one of the criteria for invitation of players to join the squad from which Inter Provincial selections will be made

3. Victor/Victrix Ludorum Awards

The annual winners of the Victor/Victrix Ludorum awards are determined as those who have achieved the highest number of ranking points for the season in question. The decision to make the award during a curtailed season is at the discretion of the Executive but provided that no more than one of the counting events is cancelled.

4. Club of the Year Award

The club of the Year Award will be made to the Club that accumulates the most overall wins in the following events:

- All women's' Saturday leagues (Pennant winners)
- All men's' Saturday leagues (Pennant winners)
- All events as defined in paragraph 2. Above

Should any one league division not reach completion in a season, the award will not be made for that season.
