To All Club Secretaries and Presidents

RE: Circular 2026 – 19: Izimbali players association.

The Izimbali committee wish to provide transparency to all currently selected players and supporting bowlers for next year's Inter-districts and beyond.

- The costs for inter-districts are made up as follows:
  - Open men and women R142,652
  - B men and women R64,940
  - Veterans' men and women R64,940
- Total expense **R272,532**
  - Spread across 48 players **R 5,678 each** (current district ruling)
- Funds raised to date
  - Barnyard R1,339
  - Donations R650
  - Academy R2,970
  - Masters and Presidents fund raising R17,3900
  - Edenvale Fund Raiser R21,700
  - Membership Fees R5,900
- **Total R49,949**
- Expected income from TV raffle, Izimbali Walk, Izimbali Bowls day
  - **R86,400**
- Remaining shortfall (R272, 532 - R136, 349) R134, 049 or **R2, 793 per player.**

For us to achieve this anticipated reduced cost, the Izimbali committee ask that all selected players do their best to:

- Enter a team in the Izimbali Bowls Day
- Sell one full TV Raffle sheet
- Enter the Izimbali walk

The players individual costs should **only** be the following:

- Bowls Day R800 x 2 = R1600 (assuming the district player pays for the full entry fee)
- Izimbali Walk R100
- Membership R100

**Total R1800.00**

Players that opt to buy raffle tickets or pay for their teams in full, do so at their own discretion and cost.

They should however, where possible, get their team members to contribute R200 each.

The Izimbali committee with the Executive, will review each players efforts and consider the allocation of the discounted cost to each player accordingly.
